A Tokyo-born musician. With a wide-ranging approach centered on electronic music, he has released numerous works on both domestic and international labels. He has performed in 35 cities worldwide, mainly in Europe, and in Japan at festivals such as Summer Sonic and Mori, Michi, Ichiba. His recent works include the album Fluctor and the mixtape LAYLAND with Ryosuke Nagaoka. He also runs the record label FLAU.



Eden Okuno Koto player

Born in Osaka, she began playing the koto at age 11 and later studied both shamisen and flute. A graduate of Tokyo University of the Arts, she received the Miyagi Prize and the Acanthus Music Prize, and was awarded an Aoyama Music Foundation scholarship. She now performs as a soloist and as a member of Hyper Koto Ensemble TALON and Rei.



Anna Takakuwa Koto player

Born in Minato, Tokyo. She studied koto from age 11 and jiuta shamisen from 14, and is active in concerts, workshops, and school programs across Japan. She also performs in the “ZAKURO SHOW” to promote traditional Japanese music, and is a member of several ensembles including the Japanese Instrument Orchestra Aioi.
